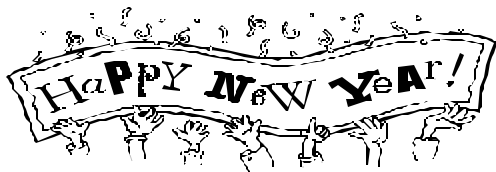
Maryville Area Day at the Capitol

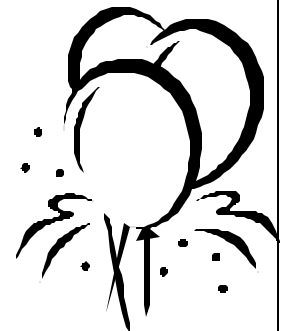
