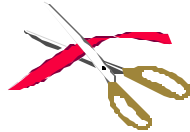

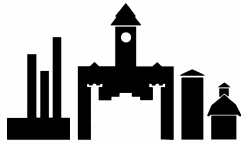
Looking for Volunteers
