### **Final Downtown Sounds of 2009 on September 11, 2009**

Friday, September 11 marks the date for the final act of the Maryville Chamber's 2009 Downtown Sounds Concert Series. Blue Voodoo will be coming to Maryville's Town Square on Market Street between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Street from 7-9 p.m.

The concert is open and free to the public. Just bring your lawn chairs and enjoy music, BBQ concessions by the Maryville Lions Club, and fun. Our rain location is at Movie Magic Opry Hall located on West 3<sup>rd</sup> Street.

Blue Voodoo is a rockin' blues quartet from Kirksville, MO. They have received airplay on domestic, international and satellite broadcast and internet radio, and have appeared at festivals around the Midwest United States.

Hot Wire (My Heart) is the third release from Midwest blues rockers Blue Voodoo. The band features the vocal talents of BJ Allen backed by a power trio of Jerry Fuller on guitar and keys, JP Hurd on bass and harp, and David Daniels on drums. Eleven tracks were penned by either Fuller or Hurd as the band continues to develop their own blues signature.
